**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2014-19-38**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$34,300 FROM CENTRAL
EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE FOR THE PURCHASE
OF PERSONNEL SCHEDULING SOFTWARE**

WHEREAS, Central Emergency Services (CES) has outgrown its paper-based personnel scheduling system; and

WHEREAS, CES has researched personnel scheduling software and determined that personnel scheduling software from Kronos best fits its needs; and

WHEREAS, there are over 950 public safety agencies currently using the Kronos personnel scheduling software; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the Kronos personnel scheduling software is \$33,521.89; and

WHEREAS, the CES service area board at its November 20, 2014, meeting voted unanimously to appropriate up to \$34,300 for this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$34,300 is appropriated from the CES fund balance to account 211.51610.00000.42120 for Kronos scheduling software including implementation.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

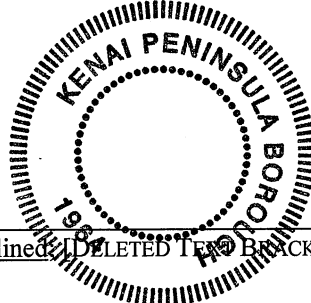
