
**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE KACHEMAK NORDIC SKI CLUB'S APPLICATION TO
THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM TO SECURE FUNDING FOR SKI TRAIL
GROOMING EQUIPMENT FOR THE TRAILS AT MCNEIL CANYON ELEMENTARY
SCHOOL AND EVELINE STATE RECREATION AREA**

- WHEREAS,** the Kachemak Nordic Ski Club (KNSC), a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization has provided healthful outdoor recreation opportunities open to all citizens of the Kenai Peninsula for many years; and
- WHEREAS,** KNSC maintains ski trails for the benefit of the students of McNeil Canyon Elementary School at no cost to the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS,** KNSC has maintained summer and winter use trails at the Eveline State Recreation Area, at no cost to the State of Alaska, including handicapped access on a portion of the trail system; and
- WHEREAS,** these trails are used year-round by a variety of out-of-town visitors as well as local ski enthusiasts; and
- WHEREAS,** trail maintenance requires periodic equipment purchases costing more than KNSC membership contributions can cover; and
- WHEREAS,** the federally-funded Recreational Trails Program (RTP) requires a resolution of support from a local governing body; and
- WHEREAS,** this request does not seek any financial or staff support of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and
- WHEREAS,** KNSC has requested the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly approve this resolution of support for the RTP grant application;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENIA PENINSULA
BOROUGH:**

- SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the Kachemak Nordic Ski Club's grant application to the Recreational Trails Program for purchase of trail grooming equipment.
- SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.

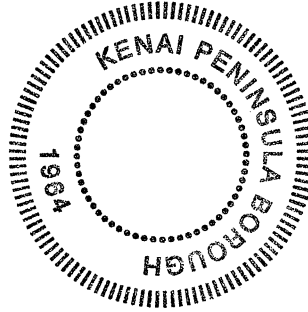
