**SUBJECT:** **LAYDOWN Amendments** to Ordinance 2022-44, Amending KPB 4.10.110 to Eliminate the Requirement that the Informational Election Brochure be Mailed to Every Borough Boxholder and to Eliminate the Requirement of the Borough Clerk to Seek Authorship Advocating Approval and Rejection of Ballot Propositions (Johnson, Cox)

- Amend the ordinance by renumbering the second Section 2 as Section 3.
- Amend the ordinance by adding a new Section 4 to read as follows:

**SECTION 4.** That for all Borough elections, for the three years following enactment of this ordinance, the Borough Clerk will send out postcard mailers to all Borough boxholders that provides information for where the informational voter brochure may be found and that a voter can obtain a printed copy with the Borough Clerk's Office.
- Amend the ordinance by renumbering current Section 3 as Section 5.
