HOCKEY TEAM AS THE ALASKA SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION
SMALL-SCHOOLS STATE CHAMPIONS FOR THE YEAR 2023**

- WHEREAS,** the State Small-Schools High School Hockey Championship game was held at the Patty Center Ice Arena on February 4, 2023; and
- WHEREAS,** the Soldotna High School Stars qualified to participate in the Alaska Small-Schools State Tournament with a conference record of 5 wins, 2 losses, and 1 tie; and
- WHEREAS,** under the direction of Head Coach Anthony Zurfluh and Assistant Coaches Dagen Walton, Lee Green, and Wyatt Medcoff, in the championship game the Stars defeated Juneau-Douglas High School by a score of 2-1; and
- WHEREAS,** this marks the Stars first-ever Alaska Small-Schools State Championship win in program history; and

- WHEREAS,** 1st Team All-Conference awards were presented to Jace Appelhans (forward), Aiden Burcham (defenseman), and Boone Theiler (forward); and
- WHEREAS,** All-Conference Honorable Mention awards were presented to Silas Larsen (Forward) and Jackson Purcell (Goalie); and
- WHEREAS,** Alaska Small-Schools State Tournament Player of the Game awards were presented to Gehret Medcoff for the Quarterfinal Game vs. Monroe Catholic High School, Jackson Purcell for the Semifinal Game vs. Palmer High School, and Jace Appelhans for the Championship Game vs. Juneau-Douglas High School; and
- WHEREAS,** 1st Team All-Tournament awards were presented to Jace Appelhans (forward), Gehret Medcoff (forward), and Jackson Purcell (goalie); and

WHEREAS, the Soldotna High School Stars qualified to participate in the Alaska Big-Schools State Tournament for the first time in 9 years by winning the Alaska Small-Schools State Title; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Big-Schools State Tournament Player of the Game awards were presented to Jace Appelhans for the Quarterfinal Game vs. West High School and Silas Larsen for the Consolation Game vs. Wasilla High School; and

WHEREAS, the performance of the Soldotna Stars High School Hockey Team for the 2023 hockey season was superb and a credit to their parents, school and community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


