- SECTION 4.** That in Assembly District 5, Dale Eicher was elected to a 1-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.
- SECTION 5.** That in Assembly District 7, Michael W. Hicks was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

- SECTION 18.** That Proposition No. 4 – Ordinance 2025-14: Annually Adjust the Sales Tax Cap for Inflation was not ratified by the voters.
- SECTION 19.** That Proposition No. 5 – Citizen Initiative: Change the Current Election Date to Align with the State of Alaska Election Date was ratified by the voters.

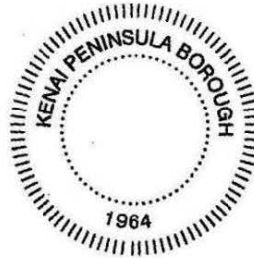
