

**CITY OF SELDOVIA
RESOLUTION 26-26**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELDOVIA, ALASKA,
RENEWING THE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE SEA OTTER
COMMUNITY CENTER FOR THE TERM BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026, AND ENDING
JUNE 30, 2029 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.**

WHEREAS, the City's current five-year contract with the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) on behalf of the Seldovia Recreational Service Area (SRSA) for management of the Sea Otter Community Center (SOCC) is set to expire June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seldovia is willing to continue supporting the SRSA with the management of the SOCC in the same fashion as the current five-year contract specifies in order to provide this service to the community; and

WHEREAS, City administration has been working with SRSA Leadership, the KPB Mayor's Office and the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Attorney to renegotiate the contract; and

WHEREAS, the contract presented before Council renews the contract for an additional three years beginning July 1, 2026, and terminating June 30, 2029, with an option to renew for an additional three years; and

WHEREAS, the agreement presented is not assignable and specific to the parties; and

WHEREAS, other amendments to the contract include staffing position flexibility as recommended by SRSA; updated insurance language; a longer timeframe for termination for convenience recognizing that such a termination would be a process and take time but with added flexibility to mutually agree to ruminant at any time; and

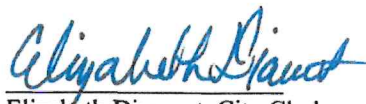
WHEREAS, all other terms from the previous agreement remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, after Seldovia City Council's consideration, the agreement will be presented to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly for consideration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Seldovia authorizes the renewal of the Management Agreement for the Sea Otter Community Center for the term beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2029, and authorizes the execution of the appropriate documents by the City Manager.
