Continued Use of the Kachemak Emergency Service Area Emergency

Communications Site (Mayor)

Since 2002, KPB has entered into annual rental agreements for space on a privately-owned tower structure north of Homer in order to provide emergency communications for the Kachemak Emergency Service Area (KESA). The rental agreements have included co-located radio antenna space on the tower and related storage equipment. The current rental agreement will expire on June 30, 2025.

KESA desires to continue its use of the site by transitioning from an annual rental agreement to a five-year lease agreement with renewal options. Securing a long-term agreement will ensure the continued availability of the site for KESA emergency communications. The lease was negotiated at a monthly rate of \$260.00 (\$3,120/annually) to cover space rental and utility costs.

This Resolution will authorize KPB, on behalf of KESA, to enter into a lease agreement to facilitate the continued use of the site for emergency communications.
