After Action Report

September 16, 2025

Storm event

The week of Aug. 25th a total of 3.64 inches of precipitation were recorded at the Seward airport (NOAA). Rainfall was heaviest on Thursday with 2.7 inches recorded during that 24-hour period. This rainfall increased the bedload downstream of the bridge causing it to be susceptible to a breach at the next rain event. The week of Sept 8th a total of 4.56 inches were recorded with the heaviest being on the 10th with 1.59 inches.

Emerging Situation

On Wednesday afternoon, Kwechak Creek left had eroded the berm down to 8 feet wide at the top. With the water continuing to rise, Metco dispatched a D8 dozer to establish the berm and centralize the channel.

- Kwechak Creek eroded in many locations.
- Sometimes Creek was moving material and eroding its banks.
- Upper Sawmill Creek is eroded north near the bridge.
