- WHEREAS, Dr. Hansen was a Boy Scout Leader; volunteering for many national and international Jamborees. He was one of the organizers of the Kenai River Marathon. He spearheaded the Bush Doctor Cabin Museum project located at the Kenai Visitors and Cultural Center. Dr. Hansen loved snowmobiling & winter camping and riding his Harley; and
- WHEREAS Dr. Hansen—along with his beloved wife of 58 years, had three beautiful children Peter Erik Hansen, Leif Owen Hansen and daughter Binget Sue Hanson. Karolee was a good singer and very musical. Her children all benefited from her talent. His family and community will miss his insight, commitment to helping people deeply, and his passing saddens all who knew him;
