KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH COMMENDING RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE KACHEMAK BAY NATIONAL ESTUARINE RESEARCH RESERVE'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY

- **WHEREAS**, the reserve system was created by the Coastal Zone Management Act (CZMA) of 1972; and
- **WHEREAS,** the National Estuarine Research Reserve System is a network of 30 coastal sites designated to protect and study estuarine systems; and
- **WHEREAS**, originally established as estuarine sanctuaries, the name was changed to estuarine research reserves in the 1988 reauthorization of the CZMA; and
- WHEREAS, the Kachemak Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve (KBNERR) was established by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and the State of Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G), Sport Fish Division in February 1999; and
- WHEREAS, KBNERR is the only National Estuarine Research Reserve in Alaska and was selected because of the diversity of habitats represented by Kachemak Bay; and
- WHEREAS, the mission of the KBNERR is to enhance understanding and appreciation of the Kachemak Bay estuary and adjacent waters to ensure that these ecosystems remain healthy and productive; and
- WHEREAS, in 2011 Alaska withdrew from participation in the Coastal Zone Management Program and hence no longer qualifies for grants under the Coastal and Estuarine Land Conservation Program; and
- WHEREAS, KBNERR transitioned from a partnership with ADF&G to a partnership with the University of Alaska Anchorage, Alaska Center for Conservation Science as the state partner in July 2015; and
- WHEREAS, KBNERR was housed in the Alaska Islands & Oceans Visitor Center until their separation from ADF&G. At that time, they moved to new quarters on Kachemak Drive; and

WHEREAS, during its 25 years of work KBNERR has fulfilled its mission. And at this time a great need exists to further enhance understanding of Kachemak Bay and ensure that its ecosystems remain healthy and productive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough commends KBNNER's 25 years of learning about Kachemak Bay and their involvement with decision-makers to ensure that local ecosystems remain healthy and productive.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
