Dear Mayor Pierce and Borough Assembly:

I am writing to request a waiver for my 2018 Property Tax in the amount of \$440.16 that is due on 10/15/2018.

I am a disabled United States Army veteran. Every year I submit my VA verification that states that I am rated at 80% for a service-connected disability. This annual submission of my rating provides for a waiver to my property taxes in Ninilchik, Alaska.

I usually become aware of my tax bill in the fall of the previous year (2017). At that time I request the Department of Veterans Affairs to send an official record of my service-connected disability to submit to the Borough. This year the VA sent the letter on September 19, 2018.

From September 2017 through October 2018, I have been regularly admitted and discharged from several hospitals

I was under the impression that I had already submitted the required disability paperwork. In the fall of 2017, I informed my spouse that the paperwork was filed with the borough, when in fact it was not; therefore no further paperwork was requested nor submitted. In September 2018, I became aware of my error regarding timely submission.
