Dear Mayor Pierce and Borough Assembly:

I am writing to request a waiver for my 2018 Property Tax in the amount of \$440.16 that is due on 10/15/2018.

I am a disabled United States Army veteran. Every year I submit my VA verification that states that I am rated at 80% for a service-connected disability. This annual submission of my rating provides for a waiver to my property taxes in Ninilchik, Alaska.

I usually become aware of my tax bill in the fall of the previous year (2017). At that time I request the Department of Veterans Affairs to send an official record of my service-connected disability to submit to the Borough. This year the VA sent the letter on September 19, 2018.

From September 2017 through October 2018, I have been regularly admitted and discharged from several hospitals [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I was under the impression that I had already submitted the required disability paperwork. In the fall of 2017, I informed my spouse that the paperwork was filed with the borough, when in fact it was not; therefore no further paperwork was requested nor submitted. In September 2018, I became aware of my error regarding timely submission.

Please accept my apologies and the attached discharge paperwork from the various hospitals. It would be very helpful if you would put this before the Assembly to vote on my request for this one-time waiver.
