AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$165,185.50 IN THE BOROUGH'S SCHOOL REVENUE CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO SCHOOL FACILITIES

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District has funds set aside for improving school facilities; and
- WHEREAS, the school district and the borough's maintenance and capital projects departments have worked together to develop a plan to expand parking at Aurora Borealis Charter School to address space and safety concerns; and
- WHEREAS, as the schools are owned by the borough, it is suitable for the borough to appropriate the funds necessary for these projects; and
- WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project is \$165,185.50 and the school district has committed to providing the funding necessary to complete the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the administration is authorized to accept \$165,185.50 from the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District for parking improvements to Aurora Borealis Charter School to address space and safety concerns.
- **SECTION 2.** That \$165,185.50 is appropriated in the School Revenue Capital Projects Fund to account 400.73010.15PRK.49999 for Aurora Borealis Charter School parking improvements.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
