SUBJECT: Ordinance 2026-__29__, Establishing the Sterling Recreation Service Area and Providing for an Appointed Board Subject to Voter Approval (Tunseth)

On June 30, 2026, the KPB Clerk certified the citizens petition establishing the Sterling Recreational Service Area as sufficient and initiated the service area establishment process. If approved, the Ordinance will place the proposition authorizing KPB to exercise powers necessary to provide recreation services and programs within the proposed service area before the voters of the proposed service area at the next regular election on November 3, 2026. If that proposition is ratified by a majority of voters within the service area, then the Assembly will enact Code provisions specific to the service area and providing for an appointed board.
