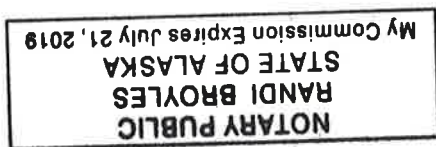

Every entry point to the restricted access area will be locked and covered by security cameras 24 hours per day. External entry points will also be equipped with sensors and connected to my home security system. Only myself (the licensee) or an employee will have the necessary keys or access codes to gain entry into the restricted access area. The window in the restricted access area will always be locked and will be equipped with an entry and broken glass sensor. The garage door connected to the restricted access area will have the electric motor disabled preventing the door from being manually or electrically opened.

Describe your processes for admitting visitors into and escorting them through restricted access areas:

Myself or an employee of Coldsmoke Farms shall ensure all visitors provide valid identification and are at least 21 years of age. All visits will be recorded on the Visitors Log which will include the visitors name, the date and the time-frame in which entry to the restricted access area was granted. All visitors will wear a visitors badge and be escorted by myself or an employee through the restricted access area.

All areas outside the restricted access area where video surveillance is required, will be illuminated by four photocell light fixtures.

An alarm system is required for all license types. Describe the security alarm system for the proposed premises:

The alarm system for the licensed premises will consist of entry sensors on all doors and windows. A broken glass sensor will also be used near the window. The security system is monitored 24 hours/day and the local law enforcement is contacted if any of the sensors are triggered once the system is armed. The system will be armed after business hours.

The alarm system must be activated on all exterior doors and windows when the licensed premises is closed for business. Describe how the security alarm system meets this requirement:

The alarm system will be armed after business hours by using the systems keypad or the keychain remote.

Describe your policies and procedures for preventing diversion of marijuana or marijuana product:

Employees will be aware that any diversion of marijuana made by them will result in an immediate termination of employment. Employees will log their time daily while working in the licensed premises. Inventory will be checked regularly to determine if diversion of marijuana is an issue. The interior and exterior of the licensed premises will be covered by video surveillance 24 hours per day. Video surveillance records will be kept for a minimum of 40 days. The video recordings and inventory checks will help prevent the diversion of marijuana.

Describe your policies and procedures for preventing loitering:

The licensed premises is on private property that the licensee owns. Any unwanted persons on the licensed premises will be asked to leave. Law enforcement will be called if needed.

Describe your policies and procedures regarding the use of any additional security device, such as a motion detector, pressure switch, and duress, panic, or hold-up alarm to enhance security of the proposed premises:

The security system has a panic function installed that once activated, a siren will sound and law enforcement will be contacted.

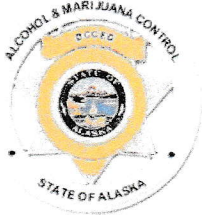

All employees will be trained by myself (licensee) in house in regards to their responsibilities, which include adjusting the height of the lights, adjusting light timers, operating ventilation equipment, mixing of liquid nutrients, feeding schedules, harvesting and trimming techniques, curing techniques, waste management and housekeeping.

The licensee and all employees will complete a state approved course and obtain their marijuana handler permits. The permits will be kept in their immediate possession at all times when on the licensed premises. Copies of all handler permits will kept on file at the licensed premises as well. The licensee and all employees shall ensure their card has not expired.

Solid waste (plant material) will be stored inside the licensed premises and rendered unusable on the day it is created. The board will be given notice not less than 3 days before the waste is rendered unusable. Solid waste (which will be approximately 90% soil and 10% ground plant material) will be mixed together, placed in totes and hauled off to the landfill. No liquid waste is expected to be generated. If liquid waste was generated, the on-site septic system would be used. Records with the date, type of waste and disposal site will be kept onsite.

Describe what material or materials you will mix with the ground marijuana waste to make it unusable:

I do not plan on re-using any soil. Therefore all plant material will be ground and then mixed with the soil from which those plants were grown. The expected ratio will be 90% soil and 10% ground plant material. Household or yard waste will also be used if available.

Marijuana will be stored in food safe tamper evident plastic containers that contain no more than 5 pounds of marijuana for wholesale. Marijuana will not be packaged for resale at this time. The containers label will show the strain or mixture of strains of marijuana inside.

These containers will be placed in a lock box that is bolted to a covered truck bed and secured with a locked tailgate.

Describe the type of locked, safe, and secure storage compartments that will be used in any vehicles transporting marijuana or marijuana product:

A steel lock box shipping container will be bolted to the bed of the transportation truck. The truck bed will be covered and the tailgate will be locked during transport.



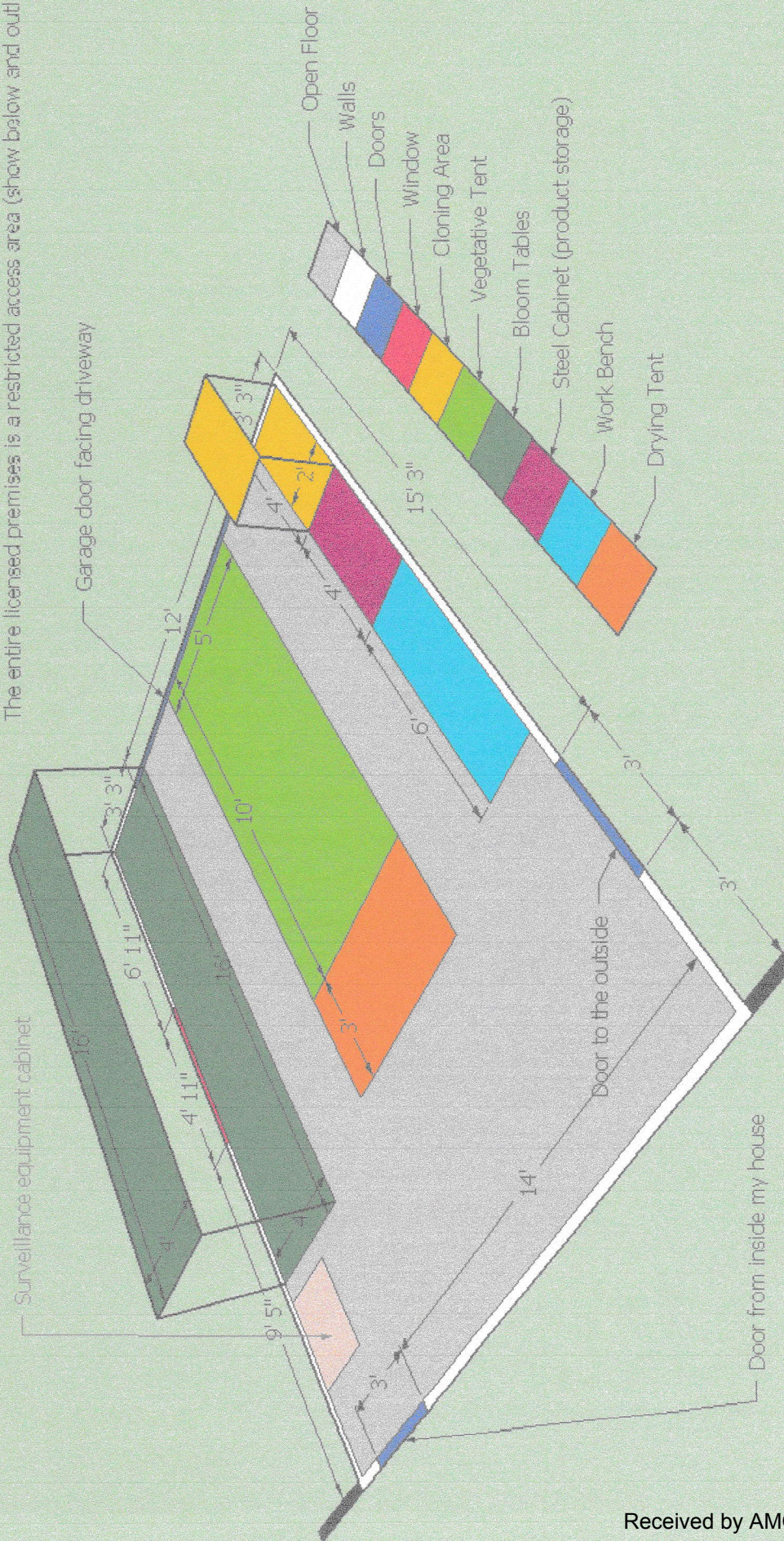

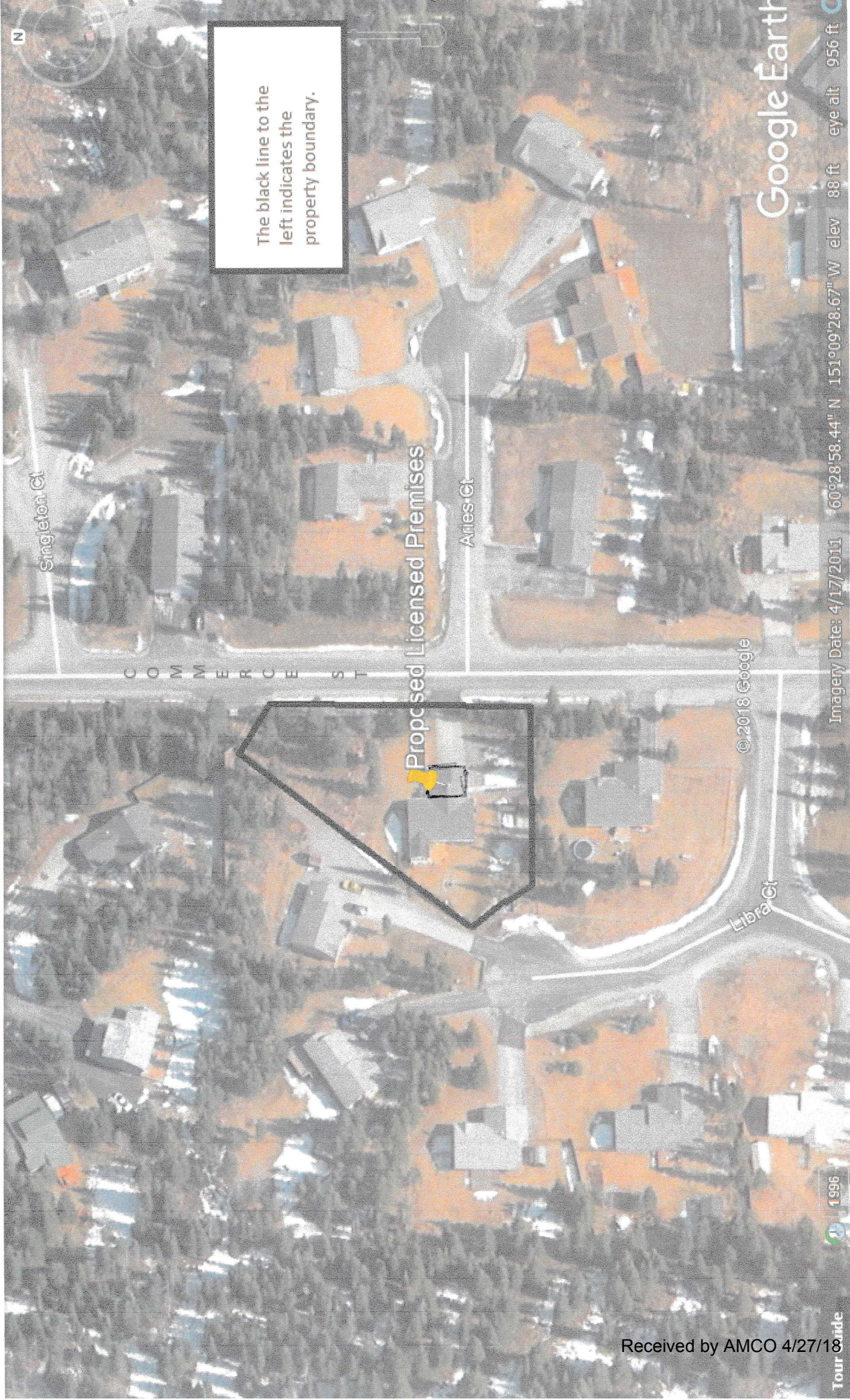

The fertilizers to be used will be Advanced Nutrients concentrated pre-mixed nutrients and supplements. Superthrive vitamin solution and Botanicare's Cal-Mag supplement will also be used. Worm castings and perlite will be added to the soil. Fresh air drawn into the premises through the ventilation system will be the only means of replenishing the carbon dioxide.

The nutrients and supplements will be mixed into 30 gallon water drums and applied to the plants by hand using either a watering container or a 12V pump and a watering wand.

All soil and nutrients will be bought locally and delivered to the premises with a pick-up truck. If online purchases are made, USPS, FEDEX and UPS will delivery to the premises.
