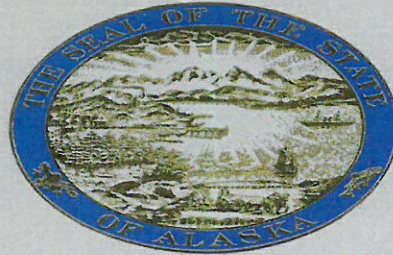

The Twenty-ninth Alaska State Legislature joins the Kenai Peninsula Borough to honor the Finance Team as the recipient of the 2015 Distinguished Budget Presentation Award. This is the 21st year the KPB Finance Department has been presented this prestigious award for its budget by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA).

The GFOA is a nonprofit professional association serving more than 18,000 government finance professionals throughout North America. The GFOA's Distinguished Budget Presentation Awards Program is the only national awards program in governmental budgeting.

The GFOA established the Budget Awards Program in 1984 to encourage and assist state and local governments to prepare budget documents of the very highest quality that reflect both the guidelines established by the National Advisory Council on State and Local Budgeting and the GFOA's best practices on budgeting and then to recognize individual governments that succeed in achieving that goal.

These guidelines are designed to assess how well the Borough's budget serves as a policy document, a financial plan, an operations guide and a communications device. Budget documents must be rated "proficient" in all four categories, and the fourteen mandatory criteria within those categories, to receive the award.

The Borough was one of 1,424 entities that received the award. As stated by Mayor Mike Navarre, "This significant award reminds us that Mr. Chapman and the Finance Department staff work diligently and professionally to assure the highest standard of financial stewardship at the Kenai Peninsula Borough. The Finance Department sets the standard that all Borough staff strive to practice as stewards of local public funds."


The Twenty-ninth Alaska State Legislature commends the KPB Financial Department for their years of outstanding performance.
