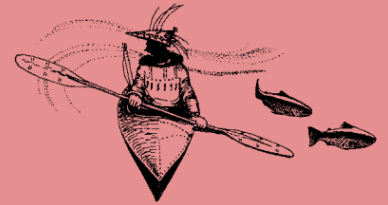

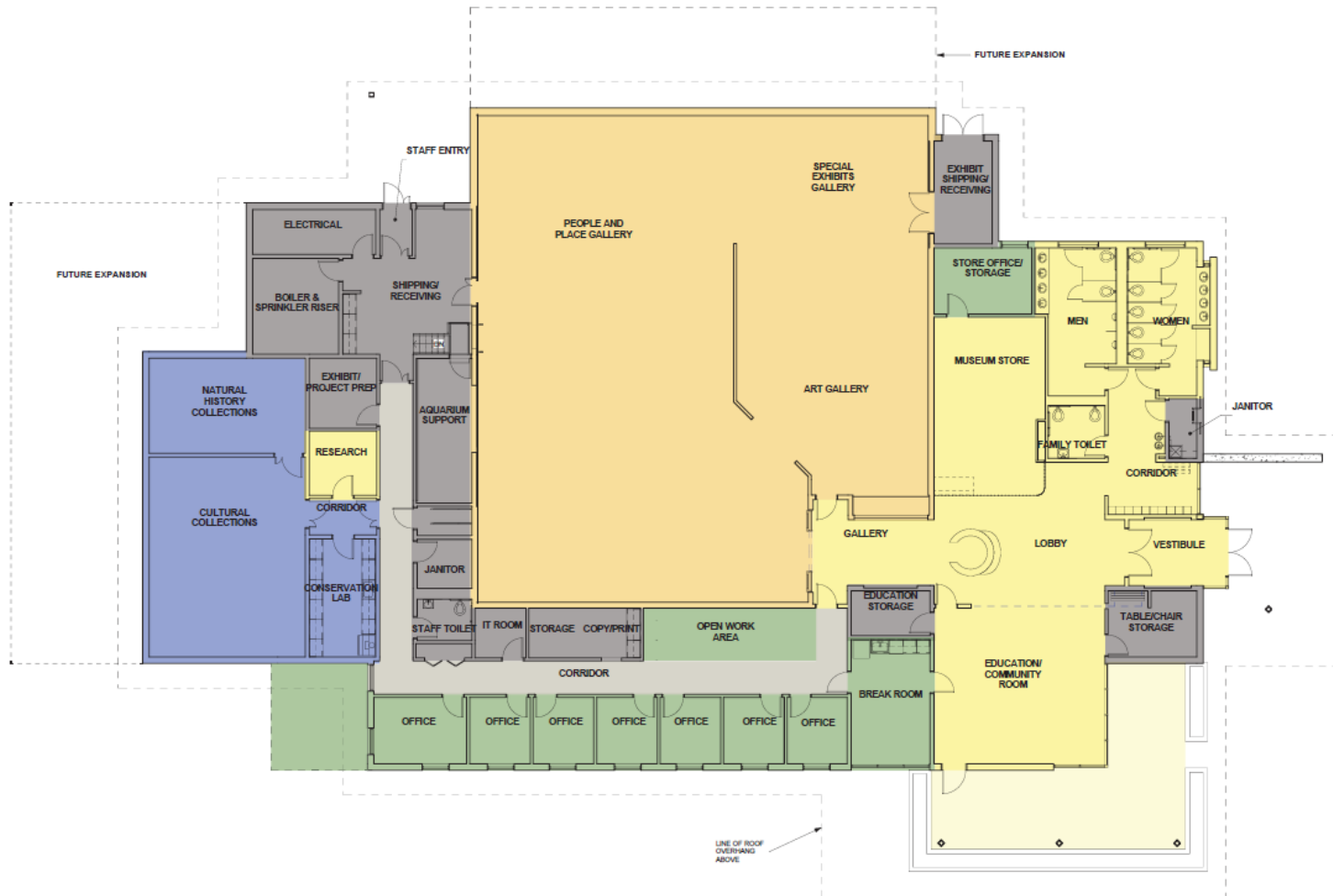

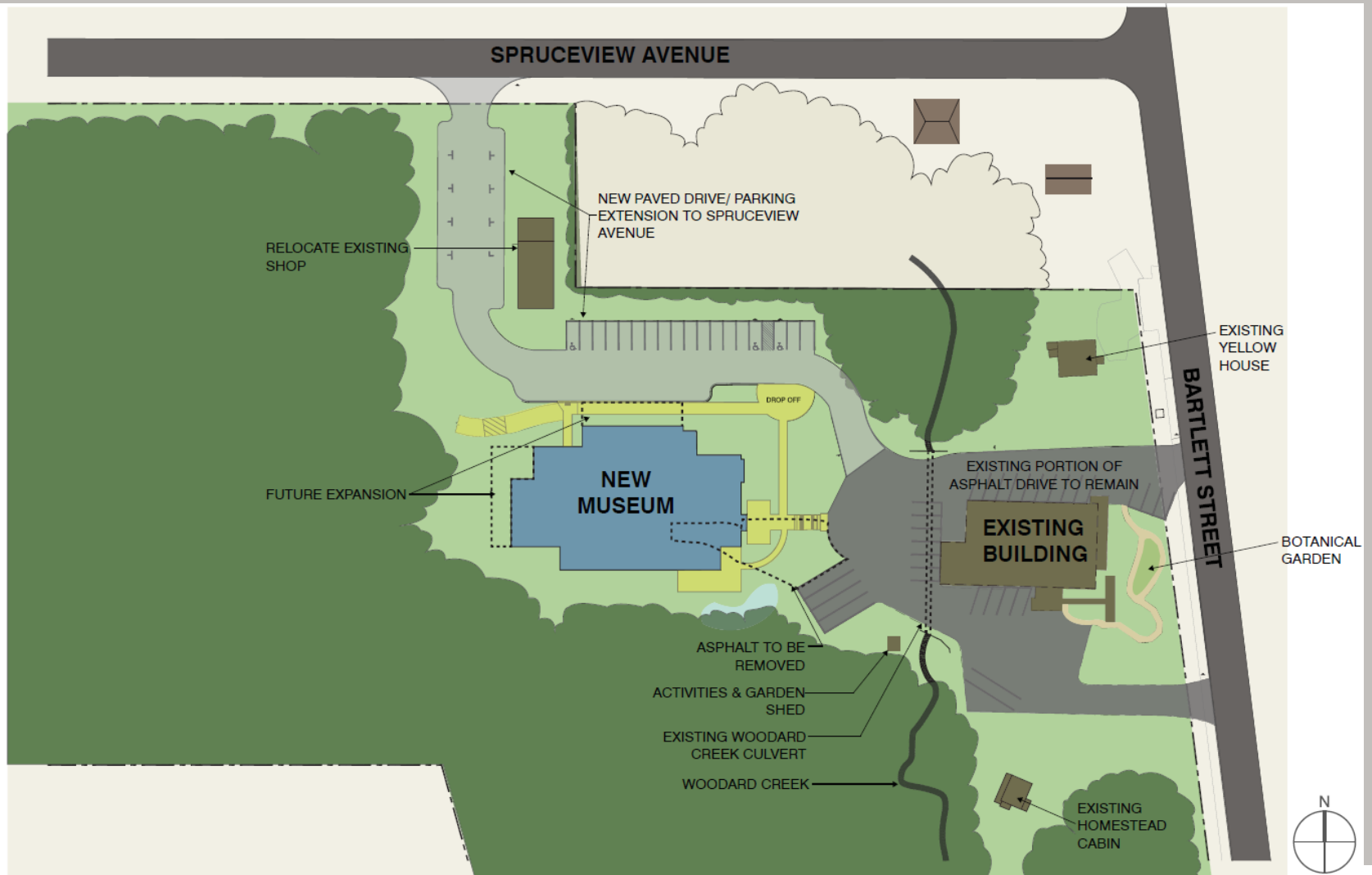

Site Plan & Existing Building

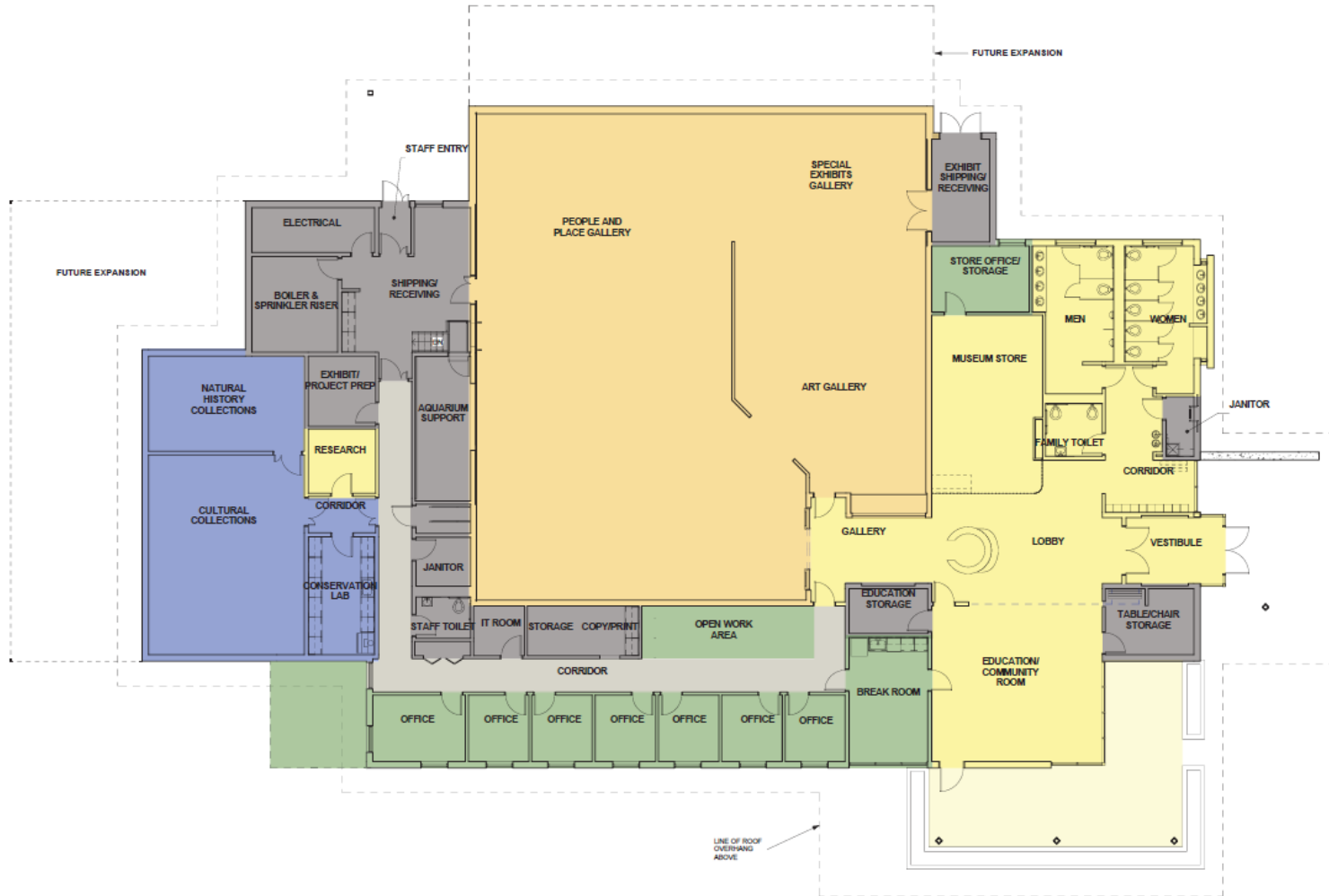

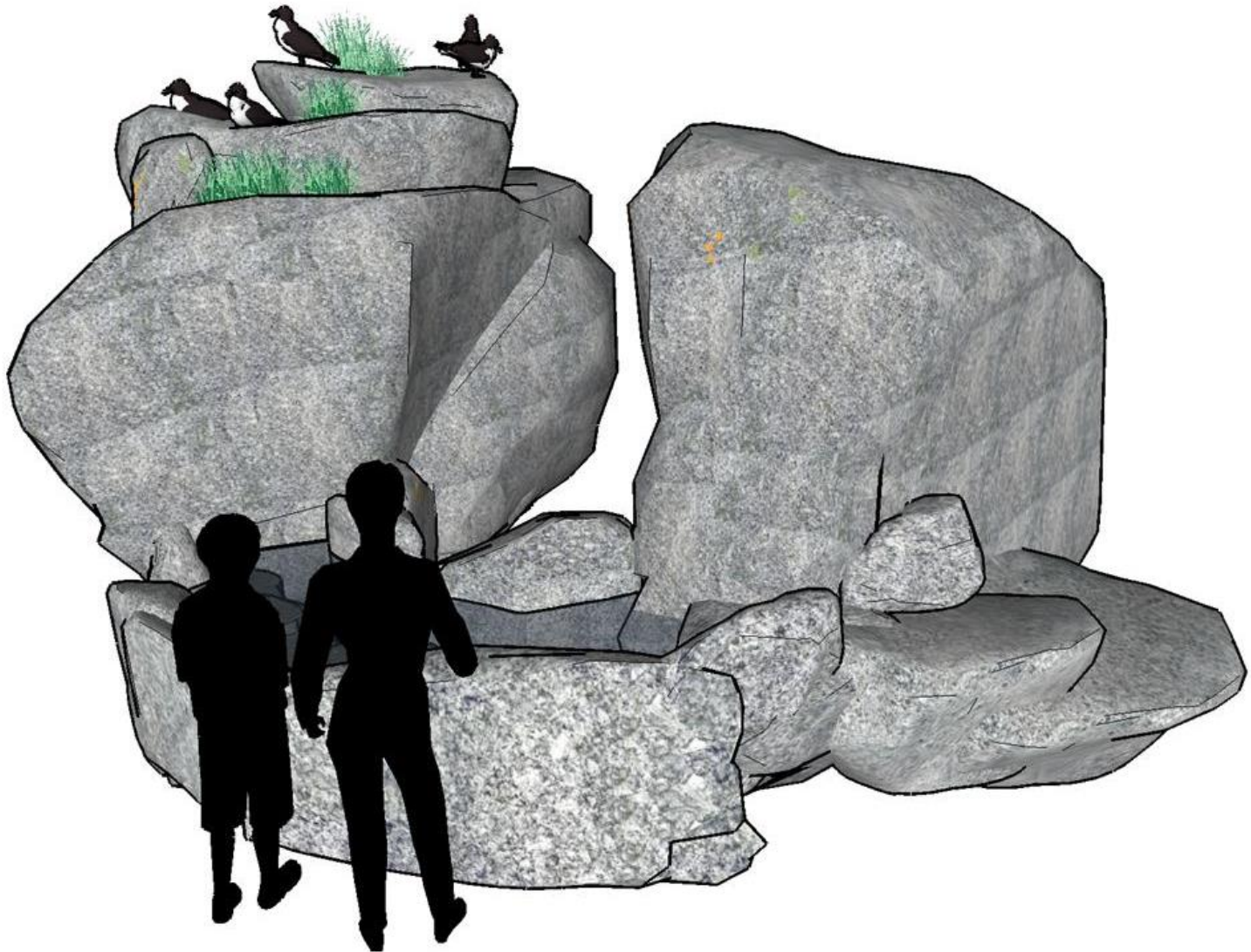

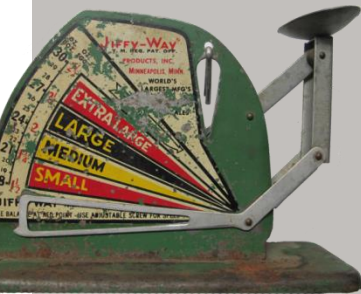
