**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2015-19-03**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDING OF \$18,000 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO PAY FOR COST ASSOCIATED WITH DEVELOPING AN INTERFACE BETWEEN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH'S CAD SYSTEM AND THE STATE OF ALASKA'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY RECORD MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the borough's new 911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system went live in September 2011; and

WHEREAS, creating an interface between the borough's CAD software and the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety record management system (ARMS) will reduce the amount of data input, resulting in greater efficiencies for all system users; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety has offered to provide \$18,000 for the funding necessary for development of the interface; and

WHEREAS, as part of the purchase and installation of the new 911 CAD system, the borough entered into a maintenance agreement with New World System for maintenance of the software;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$18,000 to be received from the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety is appropriated in the 911 Special Revenue Fund to account 264.11255.00000.43011 contract services, to cover the cost of developing an interface between the Kenai Peninsula Borough's CAD system and the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety record management system, ARMS.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with New World System to develop the above mentioned software interface.

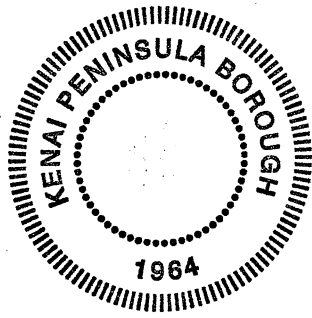
SECTION 3. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
