RE: Resolution 2022-022, Supporting Inclusion of Continuous Lighting for the Sterling Highway Safety Corridor Improvements MP 82.5-94 Project and the Kenai Spur Highway Rehabilitation Project (Mayor)

This resolution supports the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities' (DOT&PF) modification of road improvement projects for the Sterling Highway Safety Corridor (MP 82.5 - 94) and the Kenai Spur Highway Rehabilitation Project to include installation of continuous lighting.

The DOT&PF is seeking support from the Kenai Peninsula Borough to modify its safety corridor initiative. This requirement is needed in order to utilize funding to expand their projects to provide increased visibility for the projects through continuous lighting along the roadways. The Sterling Highway Safety Corridor initiative was initially supported in resolution 2012-038.

The DOT&PF has concluded that adding the continuous lighting will increase the safety of the improvement projects' corridors for all Borough residents and visitors.

The modification requires no funding or other action on the part of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
