WHEREAS, this proclamation honors former Lieutenant Governor of Alaska, Loren Leman for exemplary service to the citizens of Alaska and the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, Loren Leman was a member of the Republican Party and became the first person with Alaska Native ancestry to be elected to a statewide office when he was chosen as Alaska's eighth Lieutenant Governor; and

WHEREAS, Loren Leman grew up and graduated from High School in Ninilchik, AK. In 1972 he received his Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering from Oregon State University, and in 1973 his Master's Degree in Civil/Environmental Engineering from Stanford University; and

WHEREAS, in addition to serving 14 years in the Alaska Legislature, Lieutenant Governor, Leman is a consulting civil/environmental engineer, fisherman and a family man; married to his lovely wife Carolyn and three beautiful children; and


WHEREAS, in 1999, *Senator* Leman won the National Civil Government premier award from the American Society of Civil Engineers, for his work in improving education, developing resources and improving transportation in Alaska.
