KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2024-19-01

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$4,000,000 FROM THE U.S. TREASURY LOCAL ASSISTANCE AND TRIBAL CONSISTENCY FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE CENTRAL PENINSULA LANDFILL LEACHATE INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS

- WHEREAS, early in 2024, Phase II of the Leachate Infrastructure Improvements was bid for construction to include installation of the new leachate concentrator that has been purchased by the Kenai Peninsula Borough ("KPB"); and
- WHEREAS, the project came in significantly over available budget and was unable to be awarded, therefore KPB worked with our consultant to redesign the construction project to remove complications and improve long term options for disposal of leachate at CPL; and
- WHEREAS, in October 2022, KPB was awarded \$12 million in U.S. Treasury Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Funds ("grant funds"), established by the American Rescue Plan Act; and
- WHEREAS, it is expected that a supplemental amount of \$4,000,000 will be sufficient to award and complete construction of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the sum of \$4,000,000 in Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency funds are appropriated to account 411.32122.LATC1.49999 for the purpose of providing funding to complete Phase II of the Leachate Infrastructure Improvements project.
- **SECTION 2.** That the appropriations made in this ordinance are of a project length nature and as such do not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance shall be effective immediately.
