AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE CENTRAL EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUND TO REPLACE THE SEPTIC AND WASTEWATER RETURN SYSTEM AT STATION FOUR

- **WHEREAS,** the existing septic and leach field system at Station 4 was installed in 1991 and in the winter of 2023 the system began to fail prompting an assessment and planning process for replacement; and
- **WHEREAS**, the current system must be replaced to ensure ongoing compliance with Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) standards; and
- WHEREAS, in the spring of 2024, Central Emergency Services, with the assistance of KPB Capital Projects, began researching replacement options and in the spring of 2025 the design was completed to comply with current ADEC regulations; and
- **WHEREAS,** the final project includes replacement of the septic tank and leach field, and installation of a new holding tank and surface return system dedicated to the apparatus bay wastewater; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Central Emergency Service Area Board, at its May 15, 2025 meeting, unanimously recommended approval of this appropriation request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That this is a non-code ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$76,500 are appropriated from the Central Emergency Service Area Capital Project Fund fund balance to Account 443.51610.25462.49999 to provide funding for the CES Station 4 Septic and Waste Water Return Replacement Project.
- **SECTION 3**. That the appropriations made in this ordinance are project length in nature and as such do not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
