SUBJECT: Ordinance 2015-19-03, An Ordinance Appropriating Funding of \$18,000 from the State of Alaska to Pay for Cost Associated with Developing an Interface Between the Kenai Peninsula Borough's CAD System and the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety Record Management System

The Kenai Peninsula Borough's new 911 Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system went live in September 2011.

Developing an interface between the borough's CAD system and the State of Alaska Department of Public Safety record management system (ARMS) will benefit law enforcement units utilizing ARMS as well as dispatch by automatically transferring data once entered into CAD by the dispatcher. Currently, both dispatch and law enforcement officers have to manually enter the information multiple times. The interface will establish efficiencies for all involved.

The State of Alaska Department of Public Safety has offered to provide \$18,000 for the funding necessary for development of the interface.

This ordinance authorizes the Mayor to accept the funds and enter into a contract with New World System, the 911 software vendor, to develop the needed interface.
