RE: KPB-6906: Requesting Formal Assembly Protest to the Transfer of Location Application filed by Howling Wolf Brewpub, LLC dba Seward Doggie Bar, License No. 4747, Outside Seward City Limits

KPB 7.10.010, the assembly may cause a protest to be filed with the State Alcoholic Beverage Control Board within 60 days of the date of the notice of filing of the application for the issuance, renewal, relocation, or transfer to another person of a license, issuance, renewal, or transfer to another person of a license with one or more endorsements, or issuance of an endorsement.

Accordingly, the attached application to relocate Seward Doggie Bar, License No. 4747 is submitted for the Assembly's review and action.

The Finance Department has reviewed the application and has no objection to the transfer of location of Seward Doggie Bar.

The Planning Department has reviewed the application and has identified ingress/egress issues as identified in their memo to the Assembly. KPB 7.10.010(2), provides that the Assembly may protest an application for relocation of a licensed premise in the following circumstances:

- There is insufficient ingress and egress for traffic to the premises; and
- The location of the premises would unduly interfere with the flow of traffic.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Assembly should formally protest the transfer of location application, pursuant to KPB 7.10.010(2).
