Seat F – Marie E. Walli for a 3-year term


SECTION 19. That Proposition No 1, Prohibition of Commercial Marijuana Establishments Outside of Borough Cities was defeated by the voters of the borough.

SECTION 21. That Proposition No 3, Increasing the Sales Tax to \$1,000 was defeated by the voters of the borough.


SECTION 22. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.

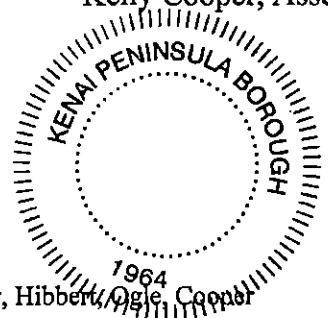
