Contract Services

- •Contractual Services, Nikiski Senior Services, Inc. The Service Area provides funding to Nikiski Senior Services, Inc. (NSC); the following are service requirements of the operating agreement:
 - Operate a meal program
 - Transportation to access services
 - Information and assistance programs
 - Recreation and social services



Contract Services

• Contractual Services, Village of Tyonek. The Service Area "Reimbursement Program" provides \$25,000 in annual funding to the Village of Tyonek for meal delivery to the elders served Monday through Friday as well as transportation to congregate meals.



Summary

- Funding for Nikiski Senior Inc. is increasing 2.5% from \$475,000 to \$486,875.
- Funding for Tyonek Village is remaining the same, there is a grant agreement in place, but no expenditures have been reported for either FY2024 or FY2025 to date.
