**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2017-34**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 2.04.030 REGARDING THE DESIGNATION OF
AN ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO ALIGN THE CODE WITH STATE STATUTES
BY REQUIRING ASSEMBLY APPROVAL OF THE DESIGNATION**

WHEREAS, KPB 2.04.030 provides that the mayor shall designate an administrative officer to serve in the mayor's stead when the mayor is temporarily unable to discharge his duties or during his prolonged absence and such other times as the mayor may authorize; and

WHEREAS, AS 29.20.360 provides that the borough mayor's appointment of an administrative officer is subject to assembly approval; and

WHEREAS, the borough's best interest would be served by amending this provision to align it with statutory requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. KPB 2.04.030 is hereby amended as follows:

2.04.030. Powers and duties of mayor—Voluntary succession.

The mayor, subject to assembly approval, shall designate an administrative officer to exercise the powers and duties of the office whenever the mayor is unable to discharge those powers and duties due to his temporary disability or prolonged absence from the seat of government, or at such other times as the mayor may authorize. The mayor will submit to [INFORM] the [PRESIDENT OF THE] assembly [AS TO] the name of the administrative officer whom the mayor has designated [TO DISCHARGE THE MAYOR'S POWERS AND DUTIES AT SUCH TIME AS THE MAYOR MAY AUTHORIZE] for approval.

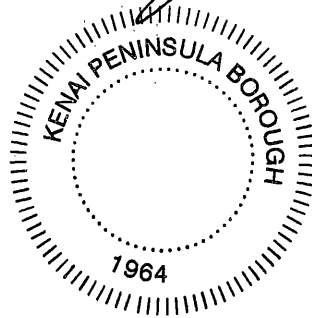
SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective upon its enactment.
