SUBJECT: Amendment to Ordinance 2023-19, Appropriating Funds for Fiscal Year 2024
(Mayor)

[Please note the bold underlined language is new and the strikeout language in brackets is to be deleted.]

- Add a third Whereas clause, to read as follows:

WHEREAS, updates to the Borough's fee schedule will be effective July 1, 2023, except for the updates pertaining to Solid Waste fees which will be effective January 1, 2024;

- Amend Section 15, to read as follows:

SECTION 15. That the fee schedule presented in the budget document is approved. **The fee schedule is effective July 1, 2023, except for the changes to the Solid Waste fees which will be effective on January 1, 2024.**

- Amend Section 16, to read as follows:

SECTION 16. [~~That this ordinance takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 2023.~~] **Notwithstanding KPB 5.22.040, which provides that grant funds for senior citizen centers and adult day care centers will be distributed propotionately to the number of person served be each existing center in relation to the total number being served by all centers that have applied for funding, the grant funds distributed pursuant to KPB Chapter 5.22 will be distributed as set out in this ordinance and budget document for FY24.**

- Renumber current Section 16 to Section 17, to read as follows:

SECTION 17. That this ordinance takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 2023.
