





DUAL ENROLLMENT UP 148%

- 217 Kenai Peninsula Borough high school students enrolled in 90+ different courses in Fall 2023
 Of the 217 students, 92 students are part of the Kenai Peninsula Middle College
 - Of the 217 high school students enrolled, 193 submitted applications for the JumpStart tuition discounts provided by the Kenai Peninsula Borough
- Students represent 14 different Kenai Peninsula Borough high schools and two home school programs




