RESOLUTION 2022-044**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT  
WITH THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE BOROUGH  
THROUGH THE SOLDOTNA PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS CENTER**

**WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough (“Borough”) operates the multi-agency E911 dispatch center based in Soldotna, known as the Soldotna Public Safety Communications Center (“SPSCC”); and

**WHEREAS,** as a part of a 2021 restructuring process, the Borough entered into fee for service dispatch services agreements with all agencies that use the SPSCC’s E911-related call taking and dispatching services;

**WHEREAS,** the City of Soldotna is a vital, valued, partner agency of the SPSCC; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Soldotna and Borough administration negotiated a multi-year agreement, with potential automatic renewals, that will provide both parties necessary budget predictability; and

**WHEREAS,** the best interests of the Borough are served by entering into this agreement with the City of Soldotna;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to execute an agreement substantially in the form of the accompanying agreement for the provision of call taking and dispatch services with the City of Soldotna.

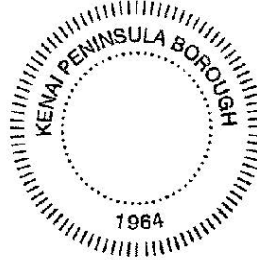
**SECTION 2.** That this resolution is effective retroactively to June 30, 2022.
