



The door will be clearly labeled as a restricted access area in accordance with 3 AAC 306.710. Unescorted people will not be allowed in the area that grants access to the restricted area.

Describe your processes for admitting visitors into and escorting them through restricted access areas:

I do not anticipate many visitors that I will allow access into the restricted access area. In the event that I do, they will need to sign the provided log book, at which point I will require them to provide identification sufficient to prove identity and age in accordance with 3 AAC 306.350. After they have signed the log and provided ID they will be given an escorted visitor badge to be worn during their time in the restricted access area. Once escorted visitors have left the restricted access area, visitors will then turn in their provided badge and sign out in the visitors log book.

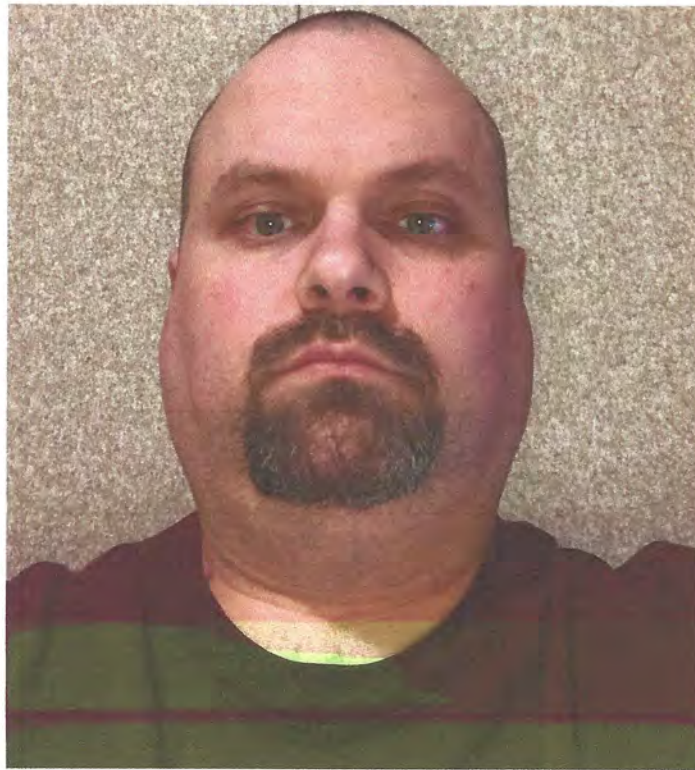

Security Alarm Systems and Lock Standards (3 AAC 306.715):

Exterior lighting is required to facilitate surveillance. Describe how the exterior lighting will meet this requirement:

I have a combination of motion sensed and continuous lights. They will be positioned around the exterior focusing on any entrance to the building where the secured access area exists.

An alarm system is required for all license types. Describe the security alarm system for the proposed premises:

The alarm system will consist of entry and motion detected events and will be monitored by an independent company. They will alert me first to an event which will allow me to determine whether or not authorities need to be called. In the event that the event is not responded to by myself it will trigger an automated response by authorities.

The alarm system must be activated on all exterior doors and windows when the licensed premises is closed for business. Describe how the security alarm system meets this requirement:

There will be entrance detection sensors installed on all windows and doors that would allow entry to the restricted area. Each sensor will be monitored by an independent company and will have an audible if not acknowledged within a predetermined time.

Describe your policies and procedures for preventing diversion of marijuana or marijuana product:

Only employees and pre screened visitors will be allowed to enter the premises. Upon exit of the restricted access areas employees and visitors will be searched for any marijuana including cuttings, mature flowers and product ready for retail sale. Security cameras will be monitored and reviewed each time someone enters and accesses the restricted area.

Describe your policies and procedures for preventing loitering:

There will be no loitering allowed within the restricted access area. There is also a no loitering or solicitation sign posted on the door that grants access to the access door of the restricted access area. Anyone who violates these policies will be asked to leave immediately, if they fail to comply appropriate authorities will be contacted.

Describe your policies and procedures regarding the use of any additional security device, such as a motion detector, pressure switch, and duress, panic, or hold-up alarm to enhance security of the proposed premises:

There will be a panic switch installed and available. If the panic switch is activated, the 3rd party company will contact authorities to be dispatched to the location as directed in the contract with third party security company. There will be motion detectors in strategically placed locations within the licensed premises. Again if the motion detectors are activated and there is a notification sent to the third party company, they will then contact a designated licensed person to validate the event and contact local law enforcement if necessary.

Describe your policies and procedures regarding the actions to be taken by a licensee, employee, or agent when any automatic or electronic notification system alerts a local law enforcement agency of an unauthorized breach of security:

Either myself or my wife will respond to the local law enforcement and cooperate with their requests. If it is a "false" alarm we will notify them of that immediately. If it is a "real" event we will cooperate with the local law enforcement agency to investigate the breach of security as well as notify AMCO of the event and update any inventory discrepancies if they should occur.

The licensed premises will have ceiling or wall mounted cameras within the facility and at the entrance of the facility that will provide a clear view of the specific area. The area will be well lit and or night vision cameras will be in place to provide a quality image of the area. Video surveillance will be recorded continuously and stored for 40 days as described.

Describe the locked and secure area where video surveillance recording equipment and records will be housed and stored and how you will ensure the area is accessible only to authorized personnel, law enforcement, or an agent of the board:

The area in which the video surveillance recording equipment will be stored will be in a room adjacent to the licensed premises. This room will be locked at times when it is not occupied by a licensed individual. The equipment will be password protected to ensure access is only possible to authorized individuals.

Paper documents will be stored in a locked filing cabinet in a room adjacent to the licensed premises. Only authorized personnel will have access to those files. There is adequate fire and or smoke detection within my home to ensure that I will have ample time to respond to such an event. Any electronic documentation will be stored on a computer with a cloud based backup device to ensure that all documents are available and secure. Only authorized personnel will have access to these files.

All product will be weighed and or counted and appropriate RFID tags will be attached to the product. The METRC system will be used to be fully compliant in tracking, transporting, destroying, and sales of any and all product.

I will only have one other associate. This person will be trained and obtain a Marijuana Handler certificate in accordance with state law. They will need to provide a copy of the certificate before gaining access to any restricted area. Once that is obtained and documented, I will ensure that this person is fully aware of what the operating plan is and train them on the specific location.

My plan is to generate very little waste throughout the operation. Plant matter should be mostly used through sale of the flower and the trim generally considered waste will be sold to a marijuana product manufacturing facility to be used in edible product and or concentrates. During harvest waste that is generated will be stored in containers for the required 3 day waiting period in the restricted area of the licensed premises. Throughout the growing process, any plant waste will also be placed in containers within the restricted access area under video surveillance for the required three days before being destroyed. This area will be under video surveillance. What plant matter that is unusable will be destroyed by grinding the plant material and mixed with compostable food waste, yard waste and or other organic compostable materials. Any wasted growing mediums will be taken to the Kenai Borough Waste facility for proper disposal.

Describe what material or materials you will mix with the ground marijuana waste to make it unusable:

I will mix the ground marijuana waste with compostable food waste and or oil and other organic yard waste in a compost site on the property where the licensed premises exists.

Any vehicle transporting marijuana or marijuana product will travel directly from the shipping marijuana establishment to the receiving marijuana establishment, and will not make any unnecessary stops in between except to deliver or pick up marijuana or marijuana product at any other licensed marijuana establishment

When the marijuana establishment receives marijuana or marijuana product from another licensed marijuana establishment, the recipient of the shipment will use the marijuana inventory tracking system to report the type, amount, and weight of marijuana or marijuana product received

The marijuana establishment will refuse to accept any shipment of marijuana or marijuana product that is not accompanied by the transport manifest

Describe how marijuana or marijuana product will be prepared, packaged, and secured for shipment:

The marijuana will be placed in a heat sealed tamper evident bag not containing more than 5 pounds of marijuana . This package will contain wholesale volume marijuana. Marijuana that will be sold to retail stores will be mature buds intended for smoking. Marijuana that will be sold to a marijuana production licensee will consist of trim, fan leaves, and any other part of the plant that is not a mature bud that is usable for products produced by a marijuana production facility. Each package will comply with 3 AAC306.470 to ensure security and tamper evident packaging. Each package will also contain a label that is in accordance with 3 AAC 306.475 including the METRC generated RFID inventory tracking tag.

Describe the type of locked, safe, and secure storage compartments that will be used in any vehicles transporting marijuana or marijuana product:

There will be a key lockable under seat and or center console storage compartment in the one vehicle intended to be used to transport the marijuana product. These consoles will be bolted down to the vehicle to ensure removal of the storage compartments is not readily possible.

Growing mediums will consist of a combination of traditional soils, rock wool, coco based, and perlite. Variations of the above listed mediums will be determined by species of plants and overall plant health.

My plan is to generate very little waste throughout the operation. Plant matter should be mostly used through sale of the flower and the trim and other products generally considered waste will be sold to a marijuana product manufacturing facility to be used in edible product and or concentrates. What plant matter that is unusable will be destroyed by grinding the plant material and mixed with compostible food waste, yard waste and or other organic compostible materials. I do not anticipate much waste from water as I plan on reusing runoff as much as possible. What little water waste is generated will be reclaimed to be used on my outside residential non marijuana garden. Any wasted growing mediums will be taken to the Kenai Borough Waste facility for proper disposal.
