## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2015-046

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PLANNING PROCESS UNDERTAKEN BY THE CENTRAL AREA RURAL TRANSIT SYSTEM ORGANIZATION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES

- WHEREAS, the Central Area Rural Transit System (CARTS) nonprofit organization intends to apply for state and federal pass-through funding to provide public and specialized transportation services to individuals with limited incomes or disabilities; and
- WHEREAS, projects funded by the Federal Transit Administration, "Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities" program (Section 5310) and funded by the Alaska Mental Health Trust must be derived from a locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan; and
- WHEREAS, a local committee with participation by seniors, individuals with disabilities, representatives of public, private and nonprofit transportation providers, and human service providers met August 26-27, September 18 and October 6, 2015; and
- WHEREAS, the committee reviewed and recommended through consensus that the Central Southern Public Transit Human Services Community Coordination Plan and the one and only project priority to maintain current, existing services; and
- WHEREAS, CARTS intends to submit grant applications and the plan to the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for the purpose of receiving the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 and Alaska Mental Health Trust funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports as a priority maintaining current existing services provided by CARTS.
- SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports CARTS and the local committee's update of its Central and Southern Kenai Peninsula Public Transit Human Services Community Coordination Plan.
