**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2017-007**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF TED SPRAKER TO THE
BOARD OF GAME, ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME**

WHEREAS, the Board of Game, Alaska Department of Fish and Game (“BOG”) consists of seven members serving three-year terms who are appointed by the governor and confirmed by the legislature; and

WHEREAS, members are appointed on the basis of interest in public affairs, good judgment, knowledge, and ability in the field of action of the board, with a view to providing diversity of interest and points of view in the membership; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Spraker was appointed to the BOG by Governor Murkowski in 2003, resides in Soldotna, Alaska, earned a bachelor’s degree in Wildlife Management and a master’s in Range Management and moved to Alaska in 1973;

WHEREAS, Mr. Spraker is a career biologist, having worked briefly with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and retired as the Area Wildlife Biologist with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game for the Kenai Peninsula after approximately 30 years of service; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Spraker has proven to be a valuable asset to the BOG and all Alaskans by solving many challenges around the state, including balancing the needs of various user groups across the state; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Spraker has gained the respect of fellow board members and groups statewide as an active, concerned, informed and effective member of the BOG;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough assembly supports the reappointment of Ted Spraker to the BOG.

SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution shall be delivered to Mr. Spraker and Governor Bill Walker.

SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.

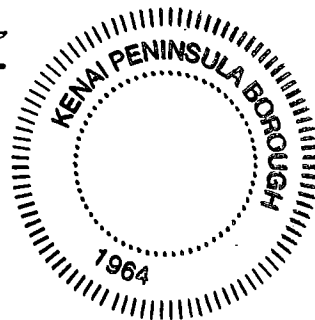
