**SUBJECT:** Amendment to Ordinance 2015-15, Amending KPB. 4.10.110 to Provide for Statements Advocating Voter Approval or Rejection of Ballot Propositions in the Informational Brochure Distributed by the Borough Clerk Prior to Each Election

---

➤ Amend the title by adding the underlined language as follows:

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING KPB 4.10.110 TO PROVIDE FOR THE INCLUSION OF STATEMENTS ADVOCATING VOTER APPROVAL OR REJECTION OF BALLOT PROPOSITIONS IN THE INFORMATIONAL BROCHURE DISTRIBUTED BY THE BOROUGH CLERK PRIOR TO EACH ELECTION SUBJECT TO VOTER APPROVAL**

➤ Add a new Section 2 as follows:

**SECTION 2.** That a proposition shall be placed before the voters of the Kenai Peninsula Borough at the regular election to be held on October 6, 2015, which reads as follows:

PROPOSITION No. \_\_\_\_\_

Shall Ordinance 2015-15, which provides for the inclusion of statements supporting and/or opposing ballot propositions in the voter information brochure distributed by the borough clerk, be enacted?

YES \_\_\_\_\_ A yes vote means you favor including statements supporting and/or opposing ballot propositions in the voter information brochure.

NO \_\_\_\_\_ A no vote means you are against including statements supporting and/or opposing ballot propositions in the voter information brochure.

- Renumber existing Section 2 to Section 3 and amend as shown in **bold** below:

**SECTION [2]3.** That **section 1 of** this ordinance **shall take effect only upon approval of the proposition in section 2 by a majority of the voters voting on the question during the regular KPB election scheduled for October 6, 2015.** That **sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance shall** take[s] effect immediately upon **its** enactment.
