**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2017-19-12**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FROM THE KACHEMAK EMERGENCY SERVICE AREA CAPITAL PROJECT FUND FOR WINTERIZATION OF THE DIAMOND RIDGE FIRE STATION

WHEREAS, the Kachemak Emergency Service Area (“KESA”) constructed a 3,500 square foot premanufactured panel building in 2014; and

WHEREAS, having now gone through several winters it is apparent that the building would benefit from additional insulation to fill various gaps and penetrations typical to this type of construction as well as general winterization; and

WHEREAS, an informal quotation process was used since the project was less than \$40,000; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive and responsible bid received was for \$12,600; and

WHEREAS, other project costs include project management, contingency and administrative service fees are \$2,400 for a total cost of \$15,000; and


WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 9, 2017, the KESA board recommended approval by three yes votes with one absence;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



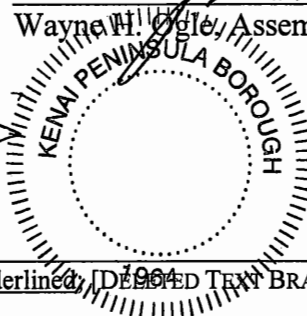
SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
