- WHEREAS, the Legal Department is currently staffed with three attorneys including the Borough Attorney, a Deputy Borough Attorney, and an Assistant Borough Attorney, all of which are administrative positions; and
- WHEREAS, over time the workload of the department has increased to the point that it needs to formally increase the level of responsibility of the Assistant Borough Attorney position to increase the scope and complexity of matters handled and the ability to deal with more projects independently, all of which also require increased levels of experience which is not customarily present at the level that would be expected of an assistant attorney; and
- WHEREAS, the best way to address this need is to change the Assistant Borough Attorney position to a Deputy Borough Attorney; and
- WHEREAS, KPB 3.04.115 requires assembly approval of all positions of employment in the administrative service either by resolution or through the annual budget; and
- WHEREAS, assembly approval is needed to change the Assistant Borough Attorney position to a Deputy Borough Attorney;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the assembly hereby authorizes the administration to convert the Assistant Borough Attorney to that of a Deputy Borough Attorney in the administrative service at level 6.
