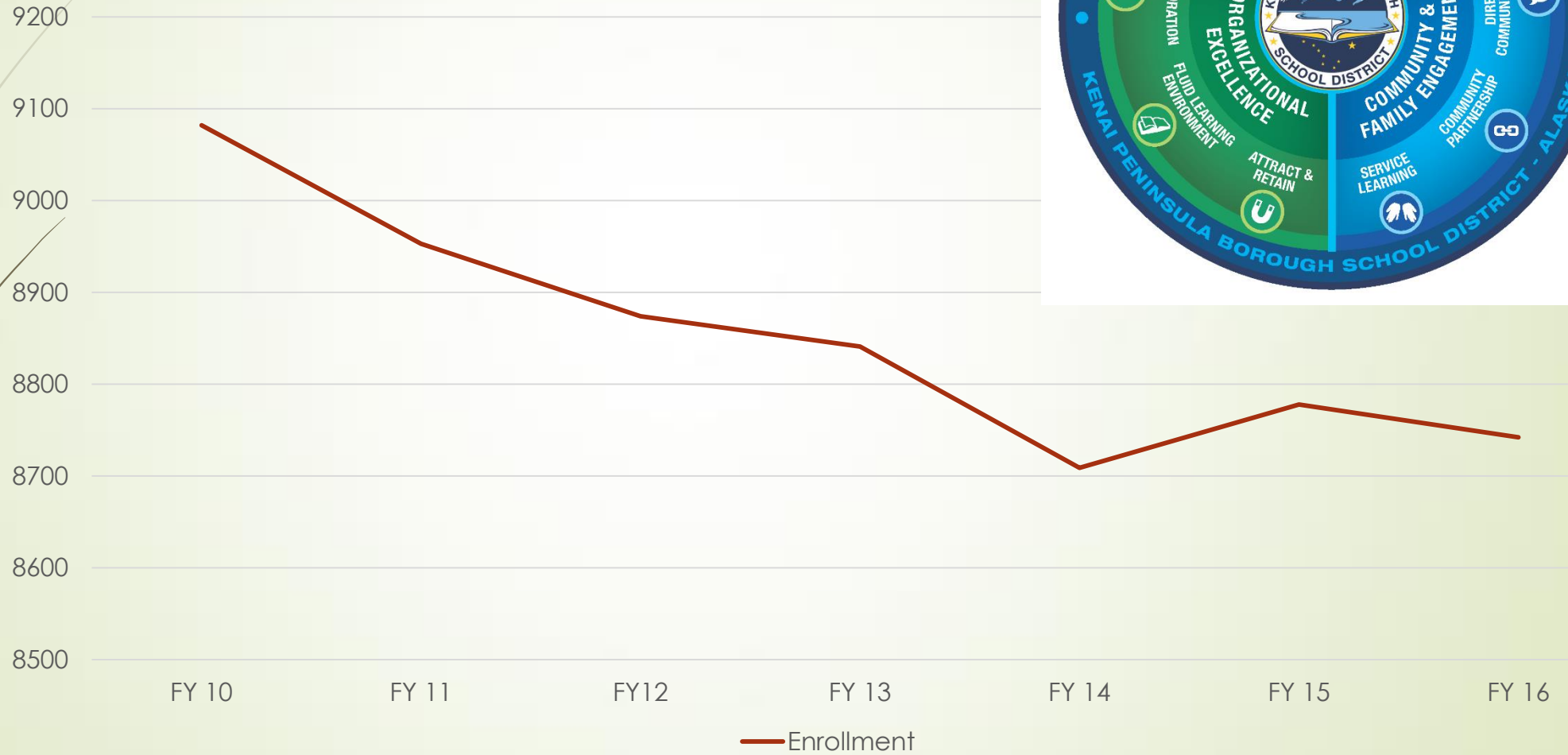

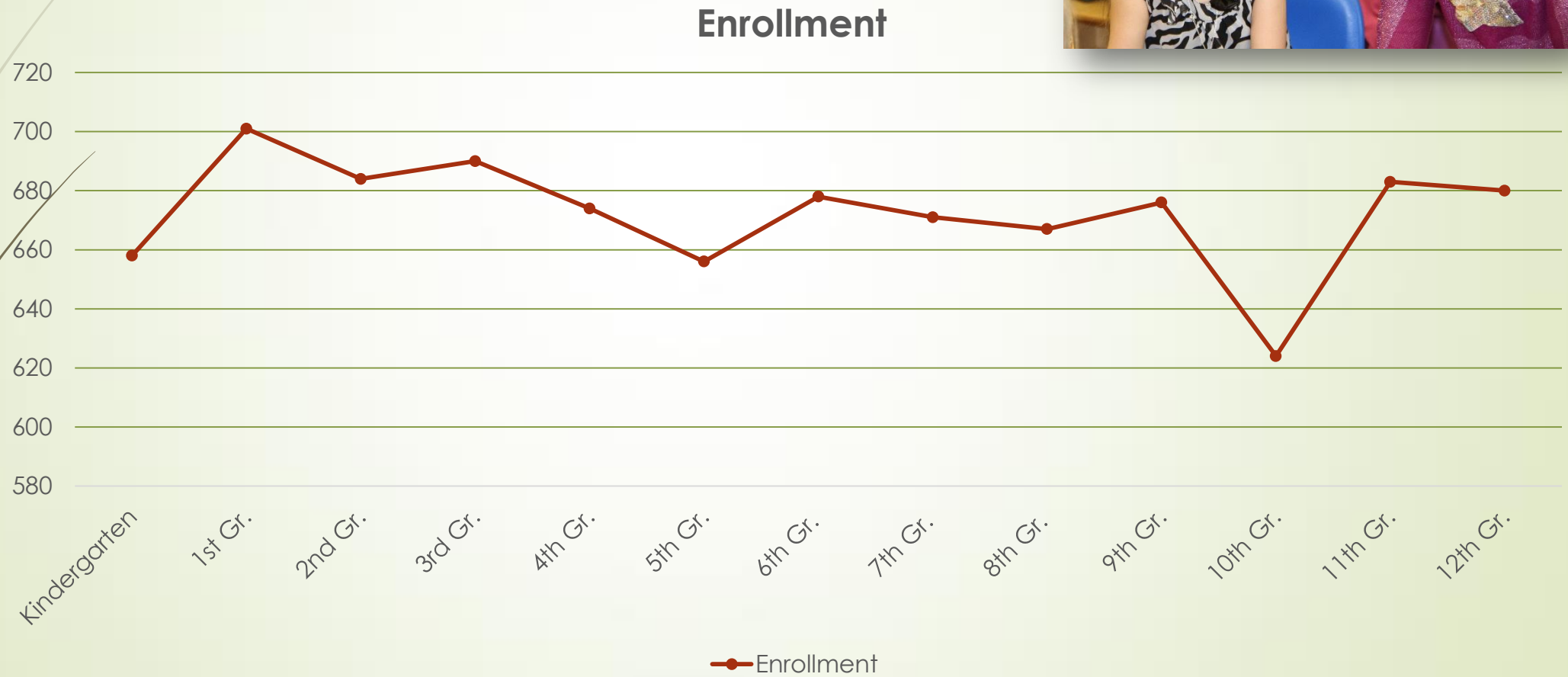

District Enrollment Trend 2009-2016

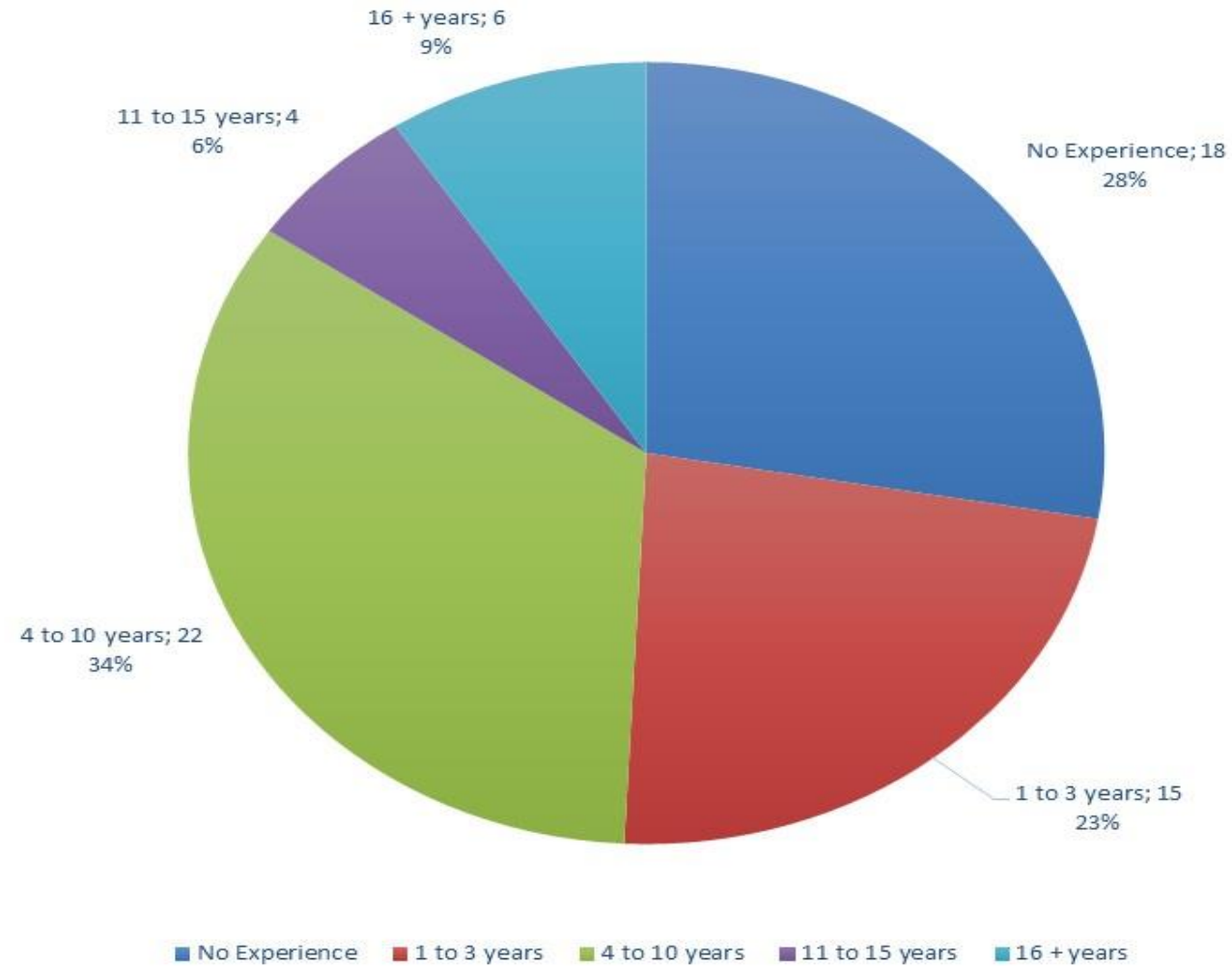


Current Enrollment by Grade Level

There are 65 new to KPBSD Teachers for the 2015-16 school year

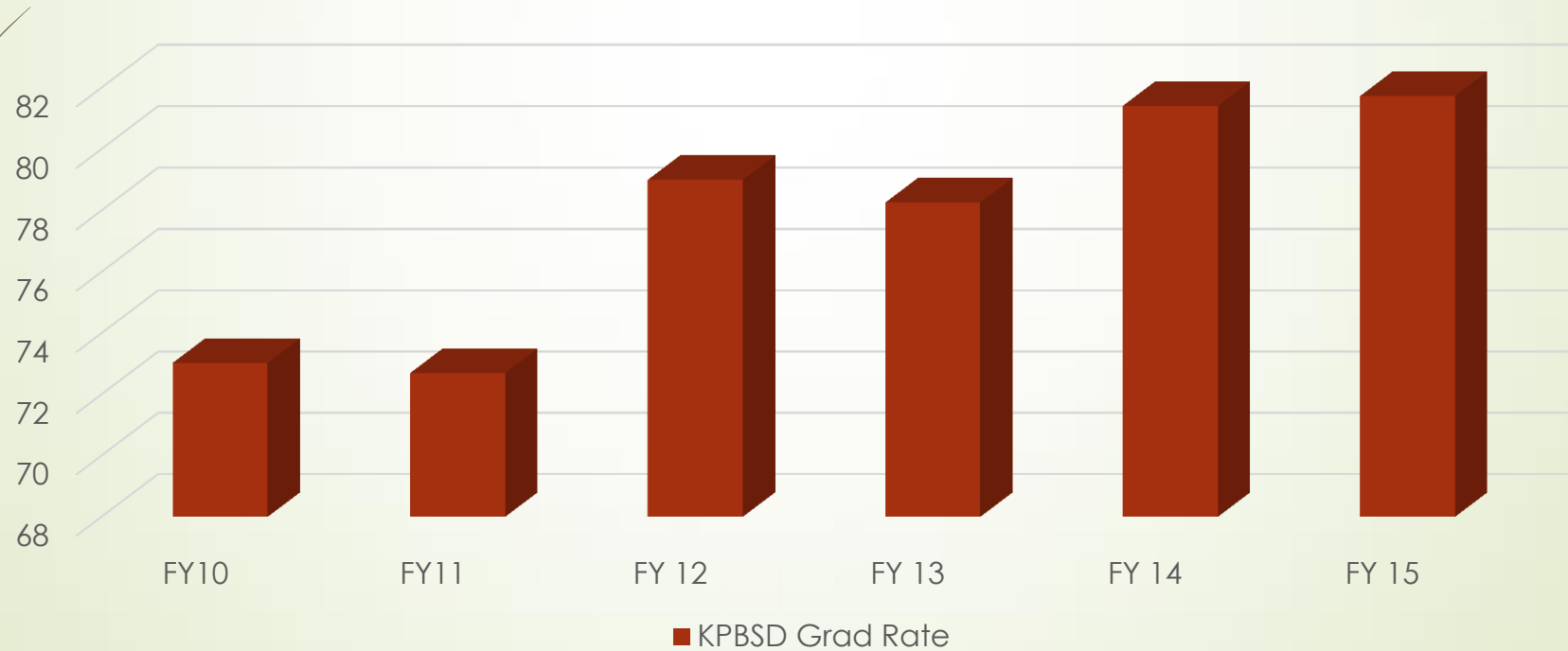




Alaska Measures of Progress (AMP) Assessment results

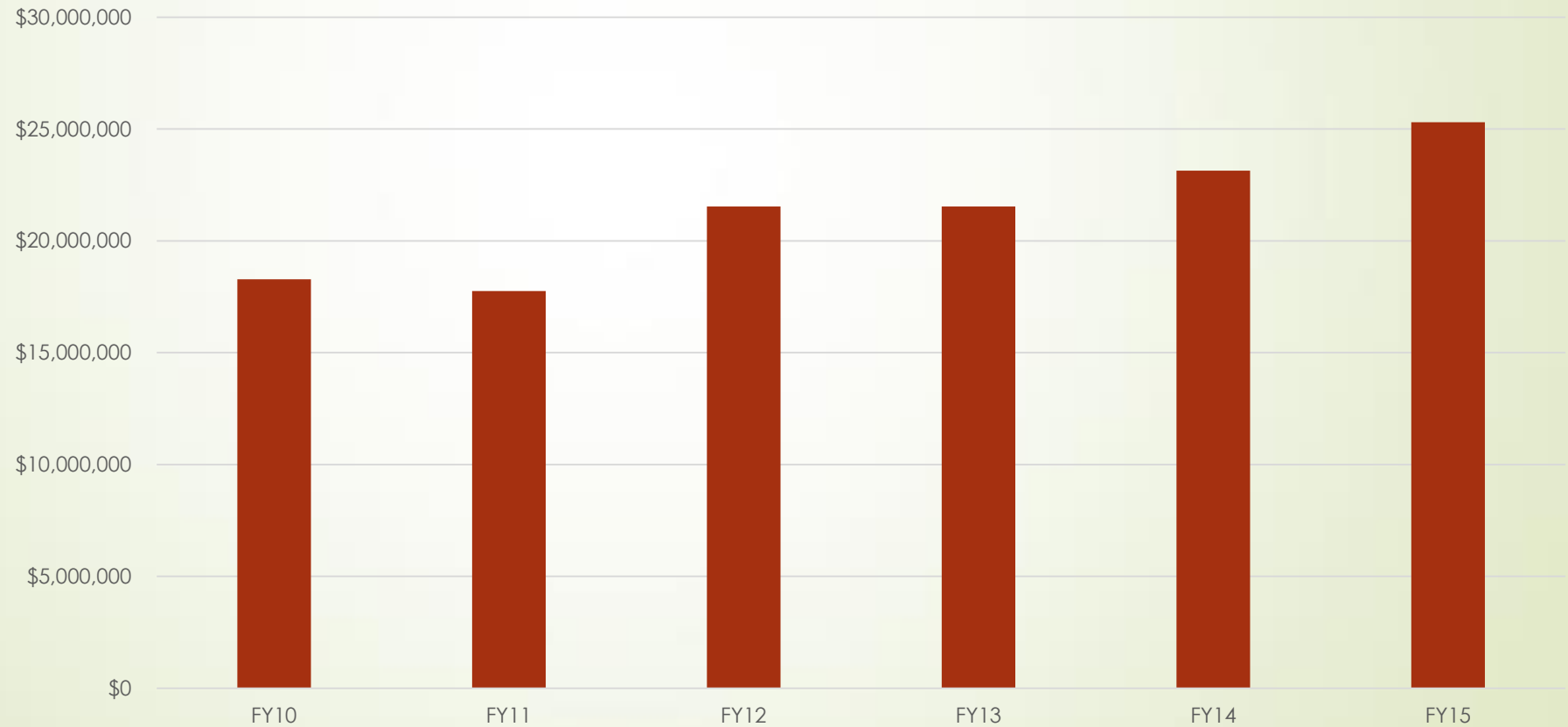
- **Currently setting meeting standards levels at State Board of Education**
