We now have a signed grant agreement completed with the state, but have not received the funding yet.

Since the last quote was over the amount of the grant, please requote both the Blue (Proposed Funded) and Green (Yet to be Unfunded – that’s smooze for dollars round #2) Lists.

I intend to submit the order as soon as we come to a list within budget. The original intent of the grant was to fund those departments that do not have access to tax dollars to raise funds for extrication tools (Girdwood, Cooper landing, Hope) and to bring all departments on the Seward and Sterling Hwy systems up to a similar level of extrication equipment.

I am still working on trying to get shipping from Washington donated.
