RE: Ordinance 2025-19- 41, Accepting and Appropriating Funds to Repair a Central Emergency Service Area Fire Engine (Mayor)

A 2018 Pierce Enforcer fire engine owned by the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) and operated by the Central Emergency Service Area (CES) was involved in a collision with a member of the public during an emergency response on January 9, 2026.

The cost of repairs and other associated costs for the 2018 Pierce Enforcer are \$152,203.90 with funding from:

- \$132,203.90 - Alaska Public Risk Alliance (APRA)
- \$20,000 - KPB Insurance & Litigation Fund

The ordinance accepts and appropriates funds from APRA and capital project fund balance towards the associated cost to repair the vehicle.

The CES Board is scheduled to consider this item at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 21, 2026, and will forward its recommendation to the Assembly.
