**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2025-19-42**

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS
FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY
AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FOR REVETMENT AND
DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS ON BRUNO ROAD**

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2018 at 8:29 a.m. a 7.0 earthquake shook from an epicenter five miles north of Anchorage which was felt across Southcentral Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Declaration DR-4413 approved eligible expenses associated with response, recovery and mitigation to be reimbursed by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the State of Alaska Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management (DHS&EM) through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, Bruno Road is the only ingress and egress to the Questawoods subdivision in Seward, Alaska and is included as an eligible project under DR-4413; and

WHEREAS, the KPB received two Obligating Award Documents in the amounts of \$281,277.30 for planning and design and \$14,063.00 for management costs for revetment and drainage improvements on Bruno Road; and

WHEREAS, there is no local match requirement; and

WHEREAS, the SBCFSA board, at its regularly scheduled meeting held on May 4, 2026 recommended approval by unanimous consent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That this is a non-code ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program grant funds in the amount of \$281,277.30 for planning and design and \$14,063.00 for management costs from the State of Alaska DHS&EM on behalf of Seward Bear Creek Flood Service Area.

SECTION 3. That \$281,277.30 in grant funds are appropriated to the Seward Bear Creek Flood Service Area account 259.21212.26HA1.49999 for planning and design costs associated with the Bruno Road revetment project.


SECTION 4. That \$14,063 in grant funds are appropriated to the Seward Bear Creek Flood Service Area account 259.21212.26HA2.49999 for management costs associated with the Bruno Road revetment project.

SECTION 5. That appropriations made in this ordinance are of a project length nature and as such do not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 6. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances will not be affected.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
