NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That in Assembly District 1, Brent Hibbert was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 2. That in Assembly District 6, Kenn Carpenter was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 4. That in the Board of Education District 2, Matthew Morse was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 5. That in the Board of Education District 5, Greg Maddeen was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 6. That in the Board of Education District 8, Mike Illg was elected to a 3-year term having received the greatest number of votes cast.

Seat C – William Runnoe for a 3-year term



SECTION 15. That Proposition No. 2, Amending the Code to Move the Common Boundary Between the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area and the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area South was ratified by the voters of the borough.

SECTION 16. That Proposition No. 3, Expanding the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area to Include the Land South of Kachemak Bay Excluding the City of Seldovia was ratified by the voters of the borough.

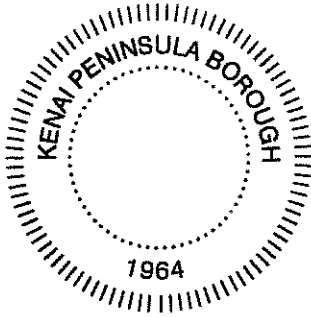
SECTION 17. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
