State statute indicates we are supposed to provide 12 month notice to DMV if the Borough was to make a change in the tax rates for motor vehicles. In our last discussion you indicated the State could implement changes to the Borough's motor vehicle tax with less than 12 months notice. The Borough is considering instituting a permanent motor vehicle tax. If the Borough provided notice to the State no later than December 1, 2016, could you confirm the State would be able to implement these changes effective July 1, 2017.
