**RE:** Amendment to Ordinance 2022-04, Adopting the Updated 2022 Kenai Peninsula Borough Community Wildfire Protection Plan (Mayor)

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The following amendment to Ordinance 2022-04 is requested:

- Amend the fifth Whereas, as follows:

**WHEREAS,** the planning commission held a public hearing on this ordinance at its March 21, 2022 meeting and recommended **approval of the Plan**; and

The plan has been updated with the following information in Appendix D, Community Risk Assessments:

1. Clam Gulch, page D15, added: Central Emergency Services and **Western Service Area**
2. Cooper Landing, page D-21, added: **Ingress and egress: most subdivision off main highway with one road in and out.**
3. Funny River, page D-38, added:
  - **Create alternative ingress/egress route for Funny River (currently only one ingress/egress).**
  - **Widen road ROWs for evacuation and fire apparatus.**
  - **Replace or repair narrowed bridges.**
  - **Harden the local community center to support evacuation, sheltering and response personnel.**
4. Moose Pass, page D-71, added: Moose Pass Volunteer Fire Company physical address **35390 Seward Highway.**
