## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2024-19-28

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SCOPE OF WORK CHANGE AND REALLOCATING THE FISHERIES BUSINESS TAX FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA UNDER THE FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH PROGRAM, AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$934.04

- WHEREAS, House Bill 69 appropriated funds from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Program to refund local governments and other entities their share of the fisheries business tax collected in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019; and
- WHEREAS, Ordinance 2021-19-34 approved and appropriated \$86,408.54 for fire and emergency services service areas and the Office of Emergency Management to address maintenance or installation of radios, tower repeaters, and communication plans to ensure interoperability and functionality (Project); and
- WHEREAS, the Project has been completed with a remaining balance of \$934.04 which may be reallocated to supplement costs generated by the Bear Creek Fire Service Area; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the borough to accept these funds;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute grant agreements and any other documents deemed necessary to expend the funds and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That the remaining grant funds of \$933.67 are deobligated from Central Emergency Services contract services account number 211.51610.21FSH.43011.
- **SECTION 3.** That the remaining grant funds of \$.37 are deobligated from Kachemak Emergency Services contract services account number 212.51810.21FSH.43011.
- **SECTION 4.** That \$934.04 in grant funds is appropriated to account 207.51210.21FSH.43011 for purposes within the scope of the grant.

**SECTION 5.** That appropriations made in this ordinance are project length in nature and as such do not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall become effective retroactively to October 1, 2024.
