COMMENDING RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING KRISTEN FAULKNER FOR WINNING AN
OLYMPIC GOLD MEDAL IN CYCLING.**

WHEREAS, Kristen Faulkner of Homer, Alaska was chosen by Team USA to participate in the 2024 Olympics as a member of the women’s cycling team; and

WHEREAS, while training in California last year, Kristen was struck by a car resulting in a fracture of her shin bone; and

WHEREAS, Kristen overcame that injury with such vigor that she was able to compete in the 2024 Olympics in Paris; and

WHEREAS, this Olympic women’s bicycle road race was 98 miles long; and

WHEREAS, Kristen won that race to become the Olympic champion; and

WHEREAS, this ended a 40-year-drought in US women’s bicycle road race medals;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough commends Kristen Faulkner for honoring Homer, the Kenai Peninsula Borough, Alaska and the United States with her extraordinary accomplishment of being the best cyclist in the world by winning this Olympic gold medal.

SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough further commends Kristen’s parents, Jon and Sara Faulkner for Kristen’s accomplishment.
