RE: Resolution 2024-046: Recommending Support for Homer Wilderness Leaders Grant Application for the Youth Trail Maintenance Initiative in Kachemak Bay State Park, The Kenai National Wildlife Refuge and the Chugach National Forest (Cooper)

It has come to my attention that Homer Wilderness Leaders (HoWL) will no longer be doing work in Chugach National Park. Resolution 2024-046 needs amended as follows:

Amend the Title to read:

“A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING SUPPORT FOR HOMER WILDERNESS LEADERS GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE YOUTH TRAIL MAINTENANCE INITIATIVE IN KACHEMAK BAY STATE PARK[,] AND THE KENAI NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE [AND THE CHUGACH NATIONAL FOREST]”

Amend the final Whereas clause to read:

“**WHEREAS**, HoWL is proposing trail maintenance projects in Kachemak Bay State Park, and the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge[, AND THE CHUGACH NATIONAL FOREST] and will take place on existing trails with the guidance and permission of State Park, and Refuge[, AND NATIONAL FOREST] staff;”

Amend Section 1 to read:

“**SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the application of the Homer Wilderness Leaders for the Recreational Trails Program Grant offered by the State of Alaska Division of Parks and Natural Resources for the Youth Trail Maintenance Initiative in Kachemak Bay State Park, and the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge [AND THE CHUGACH NATIONAL FORESTS].
