KESA King Vision Video Laryngoscope provided to APFESA

In mid-February, KESA was able to provide two sets of quality medical equipment to APFESA in the form of video equipped laryngoscope devices. This included peripheral attachments important to use of the equipment. Replacement value is estimated to be about \$1,390.00 per set with peripherals. This opportunity arose during discussions in cooperative EMS training sessions between departments, and may have been difficult to obtain otherwise.

Regular training of personnel is scheduled, and Dr. Cooper will provide guidance, input and assistance for end users to become and remain proficient in the use of this respiratory emergency response equipment. He will review and approve written procedures for APFESA prior to them being put into service.
