RE: Ordinance 2017-32, Amending KPB Title 16 to Authorize Certain Volunteers to Serve on their Respective Service Area Boards

I attended the January 11, 2018, meeting of the Kachemak Emergency Service Area ("KESA") Board. They discussed this ordinance and remained uncomfortable with supporting it. Instead, they expressed support for moving from an elected to an appointed board which they thought would help to alleviate their recruitment difficulties. As it is not necessary to include KESA in this ordinance, I intend to offer the following amendments to remove it from this ordinance:

(Please note the **bold underlined** language is new and the **~~bold crossed-out bracketed~~** language is to be deleted.)

- Amend the fourth whereas clause, as follows:

WHEREAS, the service areas facing these issues at this time include Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area~~;~~ **and** Bear Creek Fire Service Area **~~[and—Kachemak Emergency Service Area]~~**; and

- Amend the sixth whereas clause, as follows:

WHEREAS, at its meeting of November 15, 2017, the Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area Board recommended approval; **~~[and]~~**

- Delete the seventh whereas clause.
- Delete Section 1 and renumber Sections 2 and 3 accordingly.
