SUBJECT: Ordinance 2014-19-51 An Ordinance Redirecting \$127,781 Deobligated Funds From the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, Coastal Impact Assistance Program to the Adopt-a-Stream Education Program

The borough was awarded 15 Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP) project awards as adopted by KPB Resolution 2009-018, approved in the Alaska Department of Natural Resources State Plan and awarded through U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP).

To date, nine CIAP projects have been closed and the remaining funds were deobligated to a reserve fund. The borough may request redirecting a portion of the reserved funds to any of the borough's approved CIAP projects.

The borough applied for and received an amendment to redirect \$127,781 from the reserved funds to increase the Adopt-A-Stream Education Program, which will be subawarded to the Kenai Watershed Forum by way of a grant agreement.
