RE: Amendment to Ordinance 2021-09, Authorizing a Community Trail Management Agreement with Snomads, Inc. (Mayor)

After attending the February 18, 2021 meeting of the Kachemak Bay Advisory Planning Commission and hearing discussion between Commission members and a Snowmads' representative, it became clear that trail users and the public would benefit from signage at trailheads which access the Anchor River/Fritz Creek Critical Habitat Area. The APC unanimously passed a recommendation to the Planning Commission to include such signage in the Snowmads' CTMA.

I am proposing the following amendment to the proposed Community Trail Management Agreement that would be adopted under Ordinance 2021-09:

- Amend the Community Trail Management Agreement, at page 2, by inserting the bold underlined language as follows:

VII. Rules, Regulation, and Safety

C. Trail Manager shall post signs or signals necessary to guide safe use of the Trail Facilities by the general public. **Signs at the Watermelon Trailhead shall include language informing trail users that the Anchor River/Fritz Creek Critical Habitat Area ahead imposes certain specific restrictions on motorized vehicles.**
